



PRIVACY POLICY

(Amended with Decision of the Sole Owner and General Manager from 12.08.2021)

INTRODUCTION

This privacy policy (“Policy”) delineates how GoMeat Services Ltd. with UIC 206518336, having its seat and management address at Sofia, post code 1113, Bulgaria, Slatina District, 18 Shipchenski prohod blvd..and its subsidiaries and affiliates (“Company,” “we,” and “our”) processes, collects, uses and shares personal data when using this website GoMeatServices.com, and related mobile sites and mobile application(s), as well as any sites and mobile applications now or in the future (the “Website”, “Sites”). Please read the following information carefully to understand the practices regarding your personal data and how this data is processed.

You expressly consent to our processing, collection, transfer, storage, disclosure and other uses of your Information as described in this Policy and the Terms of Use at instance when you provide information to us through the Site and/or accept this Policy. In addition, through this use and interactions with the Site you specifically consent to: a) Our collection of information by automated means and to our subsequent processing and using of information in accordance with this Policy b) The storage and transfer of information to locations wherever we and our service providers have facilities.

By accessing and/or using the Sites, you agree to all the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use available at <https://orders.gomeatservices.com/en/content/terms-of-use>. If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy, do not use the Sites.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We are a Data Controller of your information. Data Controller under this Policy shall mean a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the Processing of Personal Data.

Personal Data shall be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to the Data Subject. This means that, where legally required, GoMeat must tell the Data Subject what Processing will occur, i.e. GoMeat must ensure that the individuals are provided with a privacy information notice concerning the processing of their Personal Data (transparency).

PERSONAL DATA & PROCESSING

What information do we collect and process?

The information we collect includes Personal Information that can uniquely identify you (whether alone or in combination with other data or information), such as your name, postal address, telephone number, email address, or similar data. Personal Information also includes certain sensitive information related to your finances or, for business accounts, related to the finances of your employer, such as a credit card number or other payment account number (including the three [3] or four [4] digit validation code for your credit card). In order for you to take advantage of the services provided through the Sites, we may require that you furnish Personal Information or, for certain business accounts, that your employer furnish Personal Information for you. We may also collect non-personal information from you, including information about your use of our Sites, but when such non-personal information is linked to your Personal Information, we will treat it as



Personal Information. We may also receive information about you from third party sources, such as other users of our Sites, Delivery Partners (“drivers”) and Business Partners (“Stores”).

In the course of its activity GoMeat collects and processes personal data pertaining to:

- Website visitors/users as well as visitors of our social media profiles
- Clients (Users)

Clients (Users)

As clients we refer to both individual clients, as well as to legal representatives/ employees of a corporate client, including where our business relationship are established via our website.

For the purposes of activities of GoMeat as regards our obligations to prevent money laundering, terrorist financing, drug and human trafficking, proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, corruption and bribery and to take action in case of any form of suspicious activity from our Users, along with data concerning Clients, pieces of personal data pertaining to other persons may be collected.

These may be individuals who are the beneficial owners of a corporate client and/or individuals who are the legal representative of entities.

Personal information we collect for our clients

In the course of its business activity, GoMeat may collect personal data for its clients, including:

- Full name
- Personal Identification Number or Personal Number of Foreigner
- any citizenship acquired;
- country of residence and address Main Address
- Identity card / passport or other official identity document, the period of validity of which has not expired and has a photo of the client
- Photo of the client
- Contact details, such as address, e-mail, phone number
- Bank details, such as credit/debit card details, IBAN or other payment account number
- Sensitive personal data such as political views only on the KYC/AML process.

As mentioned before GoMeat must be maximally protected that its activity is not used for money laundering and terrorist financing. In accordance with the KYC process, GoMeat will identify you as a client and whereas the client is an entity, GoMeat shall identify its beneficial owners.

In connection with the above identification, GoMeat will collect copy of the presented identity document.

GoMeat may gathers data about the professional and business activity of the client as well as other data in accordance with the requirements of the law to prevent money laundering and terrorist financing.

Website visitors

Personal information GoMeat collects when you visit our website may include information you provide voluntarily as well as information collected automatically.

GoMeat collects personal data that you provide voluntarily via our website, such as when filling in online forms/ applications/ inquiries/ complaints or when you use our email to reach us. This information may include name, positions and company (employer), contact details such as email



and phone number, as well as other personal information, which you freely decided to disclose. Personal data about you may also be collected and processed when you visit our pages/profiles in social media, including when you use these to contact us. We also receive data on you adding our page to favourites, like-ing our published content, as well as data about the total number of visitors and other similar details concerning your activity in social media. All this data we receive from the company that owns the platform. Please bear in mind that GoMeat is not responsible for the governance of social media or their data collection and processing practices, including for the use of cookies, analytics, web beacons and other similar technology. Should you prefer or deem it necessary, you may exercise your rights concerning data protection towards the providing company.

Special Categories of Data

Special Categories of Personal Data means pertaining to or revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade-union membership; data concerning health or sex life and sexual orientation; genetic data or biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person.

In connection with the application of specific AML measures related to PEPs or close relatives GoMeat may collect information about political views of its clients with a declaration. Some of the information collected by this declaration may be considered as Special Categories of Data (also known as sensitive data). GoMeat will only process such kind of information where the Data Subject expressly consents to such Processing or where one of the following conditions apply:

- The Processing relates to Personal Data which has already been made public by the Data Subject.
- The Processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims;
- The Processing is specifically authorised or required by law (e.g. for Employees this would be the case where medical information about them should be provided to the Company in relation to sick leaves);
- The Processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the Data Subject or of another natural person where the Data Subject is physically or legally incapable of giving consent;
- Further conditions, including limitations, based upon applicable national law related to the Processing of genetic data, biometric data or data concerning health.

Where Special Categories of Data are being Processed, GoMeat will adopt additional protection measures. GoMeat may also adopt additional measures to address local custom or social expectation over the Processing of Special Categories of Data.

Anonymous Data Collected Automatically

Information collected automatically when you visit or use our Sites. We and our third-party service providers may collect certain types of usage information when you visit our Sites, read our emails, or otherwise engage with us. We may use this information to enhance and personalize your user experience, to monitor and improve our websites and services, and for other similar purposes. In some instances, we and our third-party service providers may combine this usage information with Personal Information. If we do combine any usage information with Personal Information, the combined information will be treated by us as Personal Information hereunder (as long as it is so combined).

- Information about your device and its software, including your IP address, browser type, Internet



service provider, device type/model/manufacture, operating system, date and time stamp, and a unique ID that allows us to identify your browser, mobile device, or your account (including, for example, a persistent device identifier or an Ad ID), and other similar information. We may also work with third party partners to employ technologies, including the application of statistical modeling tools, that permit us to recognize and contact you across multiple devices.

- Information about the way you access and use our Sites, for example, the site from which you came and the site to which you are going when you leave our Sites, the pages you visit, the links you click, whether you open emails or click the links contained in emails, whether you access the Sites from multiple devices, and other actions you take on the Sites.
- Analytics information. We may collect analytics data or use third party analytics tools such as Google Analytics to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Sites and to understand more about the demographics of our users. You can learn more about Google's practices at <http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners>
- Location Information. With your consent, we may obtain information about your physical location through geolocation features on your device, including GPS (e.g. Latitude and/or longitude). We may use this information to improve order efficiency and enhance your user experience. We may also infer your location based on other information we collect. For example, your IP Address indicates the general geographic region from which you are connecting to the Internet.

Why do we need your personal data?

We and our third-party service providers may use Personal Information:

- to process your registration on our Sites, including verifying your information to ensure its accuracy and validity.
- to fulfill your requests (e.g., to allow you to order meat through our partners and have it delivered to you, or to provide you with information that you request).
- to fulfill your purchases (e.g., to process credit card payments in connection with your meat order).
- to customize content on our Sites (e.g., the Stores that will deliver to your location).
- to send you important information regarding the Sites, such as certain changes to our terms, conditions, policies, and/or other administrative information. Because this information may be material to your use of the Sites, you may not opt out of receiving such communications.
- to inform you of products, programs, services, and promotions that we believe may be of interest to you, including, without limitation, adding you to our mailing lists and sending you emails or push-notifications from time to time, and permitting you to participate in sweepstakes, contests, and similar promotions (collectively, "Promotions").
- to evaluate your eligibility for certain types of Promotions, offers, products, or services that may be of interest to you.
- to permit you to refer us to your friends so that we may send them a promotional offer through the Sites. If you wish to use this feature, you may be required to provide us with, and we may use, your friend's name, email address, and other information you share with us. By using this

- for our internal business purposes, such as data analysis, audits, fraud prevention, developing new products and/or features, enhancing the Sites, improving our services, identifying usage trends, and determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns.
- to enforce our corporate reporting obligations and our Terms of Use, or to comply with applicable laws.
- for purposes disclosed at the time you provide your Personal Information or as otherwise set forth in this Privacy Policy.

We and our third-party service providers may also use aggregate Personal Information in a manner such that the end-product does not uniquely identify you or any other user of the Sites. For example, we may use Personal Information to calculate the percentage of our users who have a particular telephone area code.

DATA COLLECTION

How do we collect the said data?

We, and our third-party service providers who perform services on our behalf, collect information in a variety of circumstances when you visit and use our Sites.

For example, we may collect information:

- when you register for our service, sign up for our mailing list, enter a contest or sweepstakes or communicate with us;
- when you use and interact with our Sites and service, such as when you place an order, post a review, or interact with other users or with Partner Store on the Sites;
- when you make a payment for services;
- if you log in through a social network or authentication service, such as Facebook or Google, these services will authenticate your identity and may provide you the option to share Personal Information (such as your name, email address, address book and contacts, or other information) with us; and
- if you give permission for the Sites to access your address book or camera roll on your device, for example, to send an invitation to a friend or to upload a photo to the Sites
- the personal data you provide when you report a problem with our website or when we provide you with customer support;



- the personal data you provide when you correspond with us by phone, email or otherwise
- Publicly available sources – data from Commercial Register, including published financial statements, Register of Non-profit Legal Entities, professional profile online, information published in the media..

This data is **not** used for Automated Decision Making and/or Profiling.

Legal Basis for processing of Personal Data

GoMeat legal basis for collecting and using the personal information described in this Privacy Policy depends on the Personal Information we collect and the specific context in which we collect the information:

DISCLOSURE OF DATA

We and our third-party service providers may disclose Personal Information:

- to our affiliates, so that they also may use such Personal Information for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy. GoMeat is the party responsible for the management of the jointly-used Personal Information.
- to our third-party service providers that provide services on our behalf, such as payment processing, website hosting, data analysis, infrastructure provisioning, IT services, customer service, email delivery services, targeted advertising and marketing, and other similar services.
- to third parties such as attorneys, collection agencies, tribunals or law enforcement authorities pursuant to valid requests in connection with alleged violations of our Terms of Use or other alleged contract violations, actual or alleged infringement, actual or suspected harm to persons or property, or alleged violations of laws, rules, or regulations.
- to third parties as needed to detect, prevent, or otherwise address actual or suspected fraud, harassment, security or technical issues, violations of any law, rule, regulation or the policies of the Sites, and to verify your purchase to holder(s) of any credit card(s) or other payment account(s) used to place order(s) using your account or your information.
- as required to fulfill your order (e.g., to our Store partners to enable them to fulfill your order).
- to Stores and brands from which you have placed orders through the Sites as well as their affiliates and third-party service providers. These Stores, brands, and their affiliates, may use your information as permitted by their own privacy policies, which could include sending you marketing communications and other promotional content.
- to identify you to any person with whom you interact through the Sites.
- to third party sponsors of Promotions (irrespective of whether such Promotions are hosted by us), or otherwise in accordance with the rules applicable to such Promotions. You should carefully review the rules, if any, of each Promotion in which you participate, as they may contain additional important information about our, a sponsor's, and/or other third parties' use of your Personal Information. To the extent that the rules of those Promotions concerning the treatment of your Personal Information conflict with this Privacy Policy, the rules of those Promotions shall control.
- to third party partners in connection with integration, co-marketing and certain other coordinated efforts.
- to an affiliate or other third party in connection with a reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer, or other disposition of all or any portion of our business, assets, or stock (including without limitation in connection with any bankruptcy and/or similar proceedings).
- as we believe to be appropriate: (a) under applicable law, including laws outside your country of residence; (b) to comply with legal process; (c) to respond to requests from public and government authorities, including public and government authorities outside your country of residence; (d) to enforce our terms and conditions; (e) to protect our operations and/or those of any of our affiliates; (f) to protect our rights, privacy, safety, and/or property, and/or that of our affiliates, you, and/or others; (g) to permit us to pursue available remedies and/or limit the damages that we may sustain;



and (h) for recordkeeping purposes.

We may also share Personal Information which has been aggregated or de-identified in a manner such that the end-product does not uniquely identify you or any other user of the Sites.

TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES - COOKIES

What are cookies?

We may collect information using “cookies.” Cookies are text files with small pieces of data that are stored on your computer or mobile device by a website.

Cookies we use

We use two categories of cookies: (1) first party cookies, given to us directly by your computer or mobile device, which are utilized to recognize your computer or mobile device when it revisits our website; and (2) third party cookies, which are given to us by service providers on our website, and can be used by such service providers to recognize your computer or mobile device when it visits other websites.

We may use both session cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent cookies (which stay on your computer or mobile device until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our website.

SECURITY

To ensure adequate data protection of GoMeat and its Clients, we apply all necessary organizational and technical measures provided for in the Personal Data Protection Act and the General Regulation on Personal Data Protection.

GoMeat has established structures for the prevention of misuse and security breaches, and a Data Protection Officer has been appointed to support the processes of protection and security of your data. For maximum security in the processing, transmission and storage of your data, we may use additional security mechanisms such as encryption, pseudonymization and more. GoMeat stores your data on special server spaces, which are accessible only to employees of the Company who are directly engaged in the processing of your data. Paper copies are stored in special places, which are not publicly available or available to persons with unauthorized access.

We and our third-party service providers use reasonable organizational, technical, and administrative measures designed to protect Personal Information under our control. However, no data transmission over the Internet or data storage system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is not secure (for example, if you feel that the security of any account you might have with us has been compromised), you must immediately notify us of the problem by contacting us in accordance with the "Contact Information" section below.

UNSUBSCRIBE

If you do not wish to receive certain marketing-related emails from us, you may unsubscribe from receiving them by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link at the bottom of any of those emails. You may also unsubscribe from receiving certain order-related text (SMS) or multimedia (MMS) messages by replying "STOP" to the number sending the message. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER OF DATA

Your information, including personal data that is collected from you, may be transferred to, stored in and processed by us outside the country in which you reside, where data protection and privacy regulations may differ. By accepting this Policy, you agree to this. However, needed measures to keep your data secure are always taken.

We do not transfer your personal data to countries or territories outside the European Economic Area.

Any transfer of personal data which are undergoing processing or are intended for processing after transfer to a third country or to an international organisation shall take place only if, subject to the other provisions of this Regulation, the conditions laid down in Chapter V of General Regulation on Personal Data Protection are complied with by the Controller, including for onward transfers of personal data from the third country or an international organization to another third country or



to another international organization.

RETENTION

GoMeat will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your information to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our policies. Our Privacy Policy was generated with the help of GDPR Privacy Policy Generator.

Once the purposes for which the personal data have been collected have been achieved, we will destroy it immediately.

GoMeat takes all necessary technical and organizational measures for the destruction of data that are no longer needed, except in cases where there is a legal basis for GoMeat to process it for a longer period of time; upon your request to limit the processing, according to your rights, described in detail below; or with a view to being compatible with the original purpose of the processing, of which you will be informed.

GoMeat stores the collected personal data within the following terms:

- a) when the data are processed on the basis of a concluded contract with clients - for a period of 5 years, which period starts from the date of termination of the contract with clients. Sensitive personal data collected in connection with customer identification will be stored for the same period.
- b) when the data are processed on the basis of obtained consent - until the explicit withdrawal of the consent.
- c) when the data are processed to protect the realization of our rights and interests, which have a justified advantage over the interests of individuals - until the expiration of the right and / or loss of interest.
- d) where the data are processed for compliance with a legal obligation that applies to the controller, subject to legal provisions.

After the expiration of the specified terms, if there is no other reason for data processing, they will be deleted. In order to obtain and analyze information related to the products and services you use, as well as to improve the service, the Company may delete only part of the data. In these cases, it continues to store part of the data that does not allow individuals to be subsequently identified.

NOTE REGARDING THE USE OF THE SITES BY CHILDREN

Under no circumstances are the Sites directed to and/or intended for use by individuals under the age of thirteen (13), and we do not knowingly collect Personal Information from children under age 13. If you believe that we might have any information from a child under 13, please contact us at privacy@GoMeatServices.com. We will delete such information from our files as soon as reasonably practicable.

CONTROL OVER YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION AND YOUR RIGHTS

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights. If you wish to be informed what Personal Information we hold about you and if you want it



to be removed from our systems, please contact us.

In certain circumstances, you have the following data protection rights:

- The right of information.
- The right to access, update or to delete the information we have on you.
- The right of rectification.
- Right of erasure.
- The right to object.
- The right of restriction.
- The right to data portability.
- The right to withdraw consent.
- Right to Complain before the Surveillance Authority.

In more details

Right of information: You have the right to receive relevant information of our processing of your data, which is actually the purpose of this Policy. However, at any time you may contact us to receive additional information or clarifications on whether and how GoMeat processes any of your personal data.

Right of access: You have the right to get free information about the nature, volume and way we use your personal data, and get a copy of this information. In addition, you have the right to receive information about the recipients of your data, including whether your personal data is being transferred to a country or an international organization located outside the European Union. If such a transfer takes place, you have the right to be informed of the appropriate precaution measures taken to protect your personal information.
